Graduate Fellowship Application

Deadline June 1ST 2025

The Monterey County Historical Society, Inc., invites Upper Division Undergraduate and Graduate students to apply for the Tabasa Fund for Filipino Studies. The Undergraduate fellowship alternates with the Graduate fellowship. The 2025 application is specific to the Graduate fellowship. Undergraduate fellowships will again be offered in 2026.

Application Requirements

- Must be a resident of California
- Preference is for Filipino undergraduate or graduate students who live within Monterey County and are graduates of high schools within the region.
- Graduate students pursuing Filipino studies, particularly heritage and historical studies, in northern California are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants should presently be enrolled in either an Undergraduate or Graduate program, depending on Award being administered, and be able to provide documentation of their enrollment status, and/or contact information for their college or university's grants and scholarships program.
- Recipients shall maintain a minimum **3.0 GPA** and a minimum of **12 units** per semester and/or quarter throughout the life of the scholarship.
- Applicants must be members of the Filipino community, and/or committed to using the scholarship funds to pursue Filipino heritage and/or history studies regardless of background.

The Tabasa Fund for Filipino Studies awards scholarships in the amount of **\$3,000** per semester for two semesters for Upper Division Undergraduate students, and **\$5,000** per semester for two semesters for Graduate students. The scholarship(s) shall not exceed \$6,000 for Undergrad, or \$10,000 for Graduate students per academic year.
